We are pleased to present you with the Annual Education Report (AER) which provides key information on the 2012-2013 educational progress for Conner Creek Academy East Elementary School. The AER addresses the complex reporting information required by federal and state laws. The school's report contains information about student assessment, accountability and teacher quality. The state has identified some schools with the status of Reward, Focus or Priority. A Reward school is one that is outperforming other schools in achievement, growth, or is performing better than other schools with a similar student population. A Focus school is one that has a large achievement gap in 30% of its student achievement scores. A Priority school is one whose achievement and growth is in the lowest 5% of all schools in the state. Conner Creek Academy East Elementary School has not been given one of these labels.

Some of the key challenges facing CCAE elementary school are to continue making progress on our test scores for both the state assessment, MEAP, and our local assessment Global Scholars. We will continue using the web based *Waterford* program for students in grades K-2 and *SuccessMaker* in grades 3-6. We have also expanded our RtI program which provides additional help to those students needing more individual help.



2. We are making progress on our School Improvement Plan while making adjustments annually to better meet the needs of our students.

4. Our curriculum is located on our website. All of our teachers use monthly pacing guides to deliver their instruction. We are aligned with the state model Common Core.
5. Conner Creek Academy East Elementary School uses the Global Scholar assessment in grades 2-6, the results are as follows for the last two years are as follows (2012/2013)::
Math—67%/62% Reading—69%/75% Language Arts—66%/71%
6. Conner Creek Academy East Elementary School averages about 75% attendance at Parent-Teacher Conferences (including phone conferences) which represents approximately 375 of the 500 students.
